

Prof. Dr. Markus Müller earned a Diploma in Business Administration from BA Karlsruhe in 1992 as well as a Master degree in Political Science from the University of Tübingen in 1996. After receiving a PhD from Erlangen University and multiple involvements in research projects as well as guest lecturerships at national and international levels, he joined the Economics Ministry of the state of Baden-Württemberg in 2001.
