### **Position Summary**

The German-Southeast Asian Center of Excellence for Public Policy and Good Governance ('CPG') is seeking applications from qualified candidates for a fixed-term position – Content Developer and Communication – to play a vital role in delivering its upcoming Human Rights Academy (online) this March.

The Content Developer and Communication (CDC) will work in collaboration with and under the direct supervision of CPG's PR Manager to assist in the promotion of the Human Rights Academy, as well as the production of content for CPG's website and social media handles.

Accepted candidates will have to comply with completion dates spanning the period from mid-February until mid-March 2023. They can choose whether to work in our offices at Thammasat University in Bangkok on a fully onsite basis or in a hybrid capacity (half in the office, and half remote).

- Advertise the Human Rights Academy with relevant target groups across various regions and through different media channels, including social media, and university departments,
- Create content for CPG's social media handles and website, including the production of short interviews with relevant speakers and participants,
- Create two academy prospectus comprising all relevant information on the event, including an overview of speakers and participants, a time schedule, and reading material for each teaching module, and
